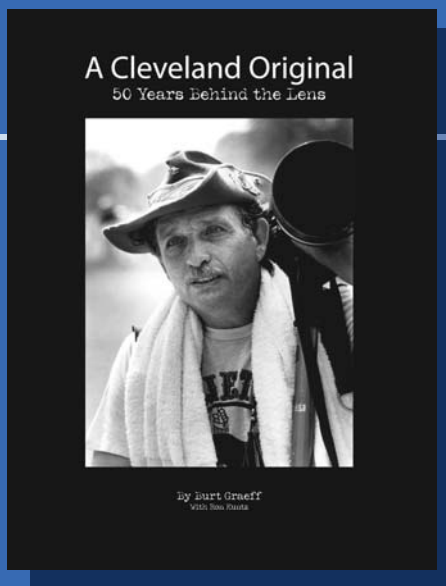

It provides glimpses of structures now gone, such as Millionaires' Row, Euclid Beach Park, the market houses, and the Detroit-Superior Bridge subway, to elements that keep renewing themselves, like the Erievue Corridor along East Ninth Street, the lakefront, and the old Doan's Corner's neighborhood and the adjoining University Circle. Each section of the book begins with a short historical essay, and all pictures have descriptive captions. The photographs come from the Bruce Young Collection, which forms part of the Cleveland State Library's Special Collections Department.

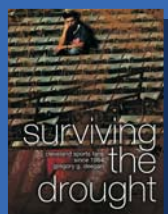
